We hope you're all keeping well and either social isolating or social distancing.

A quick reminder of the Welsh Government regulations

Everyone should **stay at home**, except for very limited purposes:

1. Shopping, infrequently, for basic necessities.
 2. Visit GP, dentist or bank.
 3. Medical need, or to provide help to a vulnerable person.
 4. Travel to and from work.
 5. Visit a cemetery, burial ground, garden of remembrance.
 6. Attend a funeral, if invited.
- Exercise is a valid reason to leave home but it should be local, involve minimal risk and be done in accordance with advice on social distancing. Travelling by vehicle to exercise should be avoided.
