A quick reminder of the Welsh Government regulations

Shielding has now ended in Wales but people in this group should continue to pay strict attention to physical distancing and good hand hygiene.

*A **household** can join up, and meet, with **three** other households to form a bubble. There is no limit to the number of people in each household but once formed, the households in the bubble cannot be changed. Each household in the bubble **must** have the same three households.*

*These bubbles also apply to socialising **in a pub or restaurant**.*

***Funerals, weddings and civil ceremonies** can allow up to 30 people at a meal, if social distancing is maintained.*
