Virus News 35 – Wednesday 11th November 2020

We hope you're all keeping well and safe. Here are the **current** Welsh Government regulations:

A bubble can be formed from two households. A household (or a bubble) can eat and drink out together in a pub or restaurant, but only four people can socialise together from different households and the households must all be socially-distanced. Only household bubbles can meet in someone's garden. 15 people can meet indoors, 30 people outdoors, but only for organised activities. There are no travel restrictions within Wales but travel is not allowed to and from England.

Everyone is advised to do what they should do to reduce the virus spread, not what they want to do.
