Virus News 39 – Wednesday 9th December 2020

We hope you're all keeping well and safe. Here are the **current** Welsh Government regulations:

A bubble can be formed from two households. A household (or a bubble) of any size can eat and drink out together in a pub or restaurant, but only four people can socialise together if they are from different households and each different household must be socially-distanced, 2m from each other, whilst socialising. Only household bubbles can meet in a garden.

15 people can meet indoors, 30 people outdoors, but only for organised, Covid-safe activities.

There are no travel restrictions **within Wales** but travel to England is only allowed to places in tiers 1 and 2.

*Everyone is advised to do what they **should** do to reduce the virus spread, not what they **want** to do.*
